Material, Design & Condition::

A lady's emerald and diamond cluster ring, cast and hand-assembled in polished, milgrained 18ct yellow gold. The design features a central square step-cut (emerald-cut) emerald secured within a fine milgrained bezel, surrounded by seventeen round brilliant-cut diamonds set within a milgrain-edged halo, including two larger round brilliant-cut diamonds positioned on either side of the emerald. The shoulders are accented with six graduated round brilliant-cut diamonds, three set into each shoulder, and are further detailed with two parallel transverse grooves. The cluster is positioned above a pierced gallery, and the ring is finished with a cathedral-style soft-square shank measuring approximately 1.90 mm to 2.77 mm in width. Presented in new condition.
