One lady's three-stone ring, cast and hand-assembled, featuring a central rectangular step-cut (emerald-cut) emerald flanked by two trapezoid brilliant-cut diamonds, arranged in a continuous line. Each stone is secured within a double-bezel setting incorporating four claws. The ring is finished with a half-round shank, measuring from approximately 2.05 mm to 2.07 mm in width. Presented in new condition.
